Participating farms are offering visitors wine tastings and untold activities including the opportunity to rub shoulders with your favourite winemakers. With more than 140 wine farms in

Stellenbosch and various Park-and-Ride areas, visitors will have a hard time deciding which cellar to visit next! Enthusiastic soccer fans can also join in the wine extravaganza as transport to and from the Festival has been arranged from Cape Town. Visitors will also be able to travel to the wine farms using their own transport. With a host of wine experiences, entertainment, participating restaurants and exclusive winemaker encounters galore, book your Stellenbosch Festival pass now! Tickets for the **Stellenbosch Wine Festival** are available on-line at R150 per person per day, and R500 for the Golden Pass for the entire duration of the festival.
